Bush Tucker – What’s NEW!

Archirhodomyrtus beckleri – Rose Myrtle

A small tree or large shrub growing 3 to 5 metres. The leaves contain aromatic oils which are very noticeable when the leaves are crushed. The flowers are rosy pink in colour and about 10 mm in diameter. The flowers are followed by yellow to red fruits which are edible.

Rose myrtle is reasonably frost resistant and tolerates a wide range of soils. It succeeds in semi shaded to full sun positions. It would make an excellent plant for a large container.



Tasmannia insipida – Pepper Bush

Small shrub to 3m in height. Flowers are cream and present in August and September. Fruit are a soft mauve and contain tiny black seeds that taste like ground black pepper. The fruit ripen in November. They grow in a shaded to sun position and like a moist, well drained soil.
